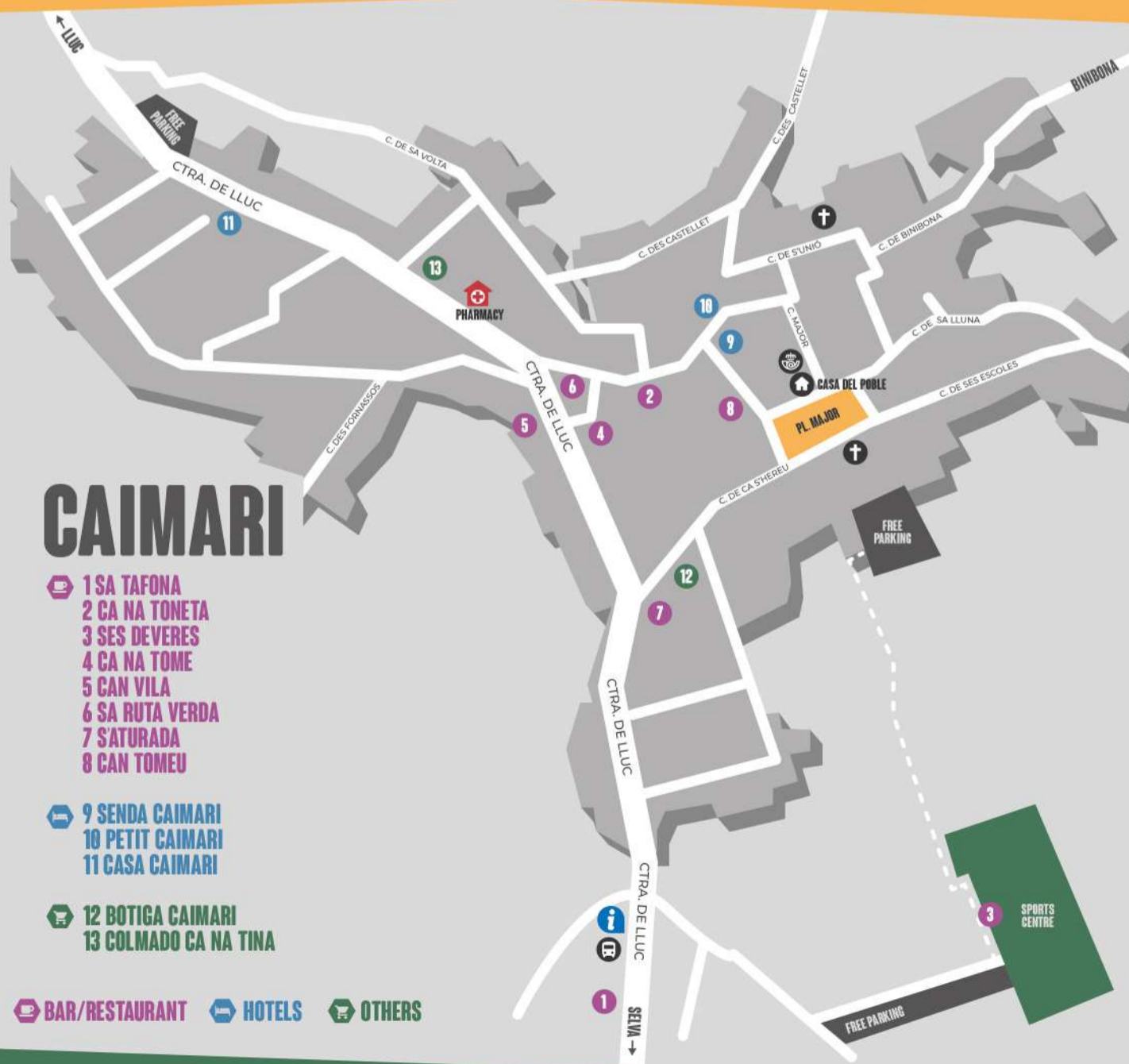

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## POINTS OF INTEREST

**MUSEUM OF FOOTWEAR KOLLFLEX**  
The museum has the ideal setting and atmosphere, a prestigious shoe factory built-in 1978. There you can find pieces from the industrialization in the manufacture of Majorcan footwear, a chronological exposition that starts with some pieces from 1927 to currently selected pieces.

**SA TAFONA DE CAIMARI**  
Sa Tafona de Caimari works using all the modern machinery to produce the highest quality, virgin olive oil. Visitors are shown every stage of the process, from the arrival of the olives to the extraction of the ready to use, virgin olive oil. During the olive picking season, it is possible to see how the oil is made, and of course, taste different varieties.

As soon as you arrive at Selva you will realize it is the kind of place that will allow you find your inner peace, and help you recharge your batteries. Depending on the time of year, many experiences await you, including dedicated hikes between and through our pretty villages, surrounded by history in the form of old buildings and monuments, including some of the oldest and best-preserved churches on the island. On our doorstep, is also the remarkable "Serra de Tramuntana", a mecca for sport and outdoor lovers, with some of the most famous bike routes in the world, rock climbing, hiking trails, and picnic areas. Rental bikes are available in Selva (also electrical).

We also take great pride in preserving our traditions, and visitors will have ample opportunity to discover the origins and methods of oil and winemaking, learning about our proud history and to watch traditional music, songs and dances during the countless festivals taking place in our villages throughout the year.

In the villages and the surrounding countryside, there is accommodation to suit all budgets, with a lot of it centered around small hotels with a well-being focus and a mix of local and international cuisine. Several hotels offer yoga classes and spa/massage packages, and some even organize hikes.

For food lovers, you will find everything from internationally recognized restaurants to family-run small bars. We are lucky to live on an island where so much high-quality food and wine are produced and our local chefs love working with the products of our land. Many of the cafes and restaurants also offer vegan options.

Our beautiful area is, of course, a lot more than we can cover in a small brochure so we invite you to go out and explore as much as you can. We will be exceptionally happy to familiarise you with all the activities on offer in much more details in the tourism office in Selva.

## EXPLORE OUR ROUTES

### 1. COMUNA DE CAIMARI

This trek starts from the picnic area called es Fornassos. The path goes through an area of dense vegetation and the trek is quite steep. These mountains are part of our history and therefore many of our popular tales take place within this area. Once we have reached the viewpoint our effort will be rewarded with amazing views, as you will be able to see a great deal from the island. From here you can decide to walk about 20 more minutes and reach es Puig de sa Creu with even better views, or turn to the right and walk back to Caimari following another path, es Puig de n'Escuder.

### 2. SES FIGUEROLES

Starting from Binibona, this path will take you to the 'villas' of ses Figueroles and Alcanella. The road was initially used for carriages driving in between walls of stones (Marges, pedra en sec). You can also walk through the adjacent mountains or even join the old path that takes you to the Cloister of Lluc.

### 3. COMUNA DE BINIAMAR

This piece of land has been used over the years as an area to share and to make profit from, especially for those who didn't own any land, so they could take wood, fruits, plants, or even use it for pasture. Nowadays you will find resting picnic areas, wide and clean roads where you can discover about 170 different plant species and witness the industry procedures that took place not that long ago.

### 4. CAMÍ VELL DE LLUC

This is not only one of the most famous paths for pilgrims in Mallorca, but also when it comes to cycling, it is one of the most visited routes. Throughout history, many people from all over the island walked this path to complete a promise or to show their faith. Along with the walk, you'll be able to appreciate paths dating from Roman times, while some others have been recently restored. The way back can be done in the same way or, in case you are tired, you can also take a bus.

### 5. ORATORI DE CRIST REI

This easy walk with a duration of about 30 min will take you to what remains of this shrine, located near ancient ruins of the first people that lived here in Mallorca. Great scenic views of the landscape together with picnic facilities makes this spot the perfect place to spend some quality family-time!

### 6. MIRADOR DE CAIMARI

A perfect walk for a brief morning activity, the way is steep but the effort is rewarded with the incredible views from the top.
